



Pre- Anesthesia Consent

Please print this form, complete it and bring it to the hospital at the time of your pet's appointment.

Your pet is scheduled for surgery and/or anesthesia. Because we consider no surgery to be "routine" we **REQUIRE** pre-anesthetic blood tests to minimize the risks to your pet during this procedure. To ensure that your pet is safe and comfortable while under our care, a single injection of pain medication is given at no extra charge.

BLOODWORK IS REQUIRED FOR ANY PET GOING UNDER ANESTHESIA

These tests help our staff to assess any underlying health concerns that might affect the outcome of your pet's surgery/anesthesia, including kidney or liver disorders, hydration status, blood volume, blood clotting components, infection and blood sugar levels. Based on the findings, our doctors will be able to pick the anesthesia protocol safest for your individual pet. **We will keep these records on file for reference in the event that your pet becomes ill in the future.**

SEDATIVE/ANESTHESIA RELEASE

You are to use all reasonable precaution against injury, escape, or death of my pet. I understand that all anesthetics involve some minimal risk to my pet. The hospital will not be held liable or responsible for adverse effects of anesthesia.

Pro V Seal - Pro V Seal is a clear gel coating applied to clean dry teeth to seal out tartar, plaque and bacteria. It helps to extend the period of time between professional cleanings.
